

Call for Nominations to Serve on the IRBA's Audit Development Committee

The Independent Regulatory Board for Auditors (IRBA) is a statutory body established in terms of Section 3 of the Auditing Profession Act (Act No. 26 of 2005), as amended. Its functions with regard to setting out RA professional competency requirements are established in sections 4(1)(c) and 7(1)(f) of the Act.

Audit Development Programme Committee (ADCOM) is constituted as a standing subcommittee of the Education and Transformation Committee (EDCOM) in terms of section 16.4.3 of the terms of reference for EDCOM. To this end, EDCOM has established the Audit Development Committee (ADCOM), as its subcommittee responsible for all aspects relating to the registration, monitoring and assessment of the Audit Development Programme (ADP). Through the EDCOM, the IRBA hereby calls for nominations onto the ADCOM. In making its decision on who should serve on ADCOM, EDCOM shall consider, among others, the following:

- Independence in mind, fact and appearance;
- Qualifications;
- Professional affiliations;
- Race;
- Gender;
- Geographical representation; and
- Skills and experience.

Applicants are required to have skills and experience, particularly a good working knowledge of the competencies required from a Registered Auditor (RA), and these include technical and non-technical competencies as set out in the competency framework.

The required skills and experience include:

- A qualified Chartered Accountant CA(SA) (SAICA and/or ACCA)
- Being an RA would be advantageous.
- Extensive practical audit experience at a senior management level; and/or
- Extensive audit experience in academia at a senior management level.

In addition, the following experience will be beneficial for the vacancy:

- Experience in the ACCA academic programme and/or
- Experience in the ACCA training programme.

The term of office of ADCOM members shall be three years, renewable once at the EDCOM's discretion.
