REGISTRATION ON THE NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

As part of the National Treasury's Supply Chain Management Reform, all suppliers/service providers who are interested in doing business with government and any state-owned entities must register on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) by 1 April 2016. This means all the suppliers/service providers who wish to do business with the IRBA will have to register with the National Treasury directly, as per its Circular No.3 of 2015/2016 – Central Data Base.

All departments, constitutional institutions and public entities, including the IRBA, will no longer be able to conduct business with suppliers/service providers who are not registered on the CSD. Therefore, registration on the CSD will provide you with an opportunity to do business with all organs of state.
