

NOMINATIONS TO THE INSPECTIONS COMMITTEE

In terms of Section 20(2)(d) of the Auditing Profession Act No. 26 of 2005, as amended, the Board of the Independent Regulatory Board for Auditors (IRBA) must establish an Inspections Committee (INSCOM) and appoint its members. The committee is responsible for monitoring the process and outcomes of IRBA inspections on registered auditors in South Africa.

The Board requires the nomination of suitably qualified and experienced persons, who are not directly or indirectly involved in public practice. Also, the nominees should not be members of the IRBA's Investigating Committee or the Disciplinary Committee.

A member of the INSCOM will hold office for a period not exceeding three years and may be reappointed but may not serve more than two consecutive terms. The appointed members' first term will commence on 1 April 2024 and expire on 31 March 2027.

Applications must include a curriculum vitae (CV) that details the applicant's knowledge and experience in an executive role or higher; seven years' post-CA (SA), or equivalent qualification, experience in external auditing, or any other relevant experience in commerce or academia, among others; and copies of qualifications. Specialisation in any of the following fields, or an equivalent, will be advantageous:

- Investor/financial analysis;
- Financial reporting;
- Information technology audit; and
- Banking/insurance.
