We are thrilled to announce a major milestone in the evolution of the Audit Development Programme (ADP), the official launch of the Learning Management System (LMS).

What's New?

The LMS represents a significant leap forward in how learning and development are delivered within the ADP. This robust digital platform is designed to **streamline the administration**, **documentation**, **tracking**, **reporting**, **and automation** of educational content and training programmes, ensuring a more efficient and engaging experience for all ADP stakeholders.

Progress So Far:

- Phase 1 of the rollout is officially complete! As of 01
 July 2025, the first 200 Registered Candidate
 Auditors (RCAs) who joined the ADP in the past 12
 months have been successfully onboarded to the new
 LMS platform.
- Phase 2 is now underway: All RCAs who register on the ADP from 01 July 2025 onwards will be onboarded directly onto the LMS.

Looking ahead, the Final Phase is scheduled for 01

April 2026, when all remaining ADP candidates registered on the ADP before 31 March 2024 and did

not submit their POEs will be migrated to the LMS.

This is a **final call** to all the candidates who have

started their POEs manually to submit their POEs

before the deadline!

What to Expect:

Registered Candidate Auditors (RCAs) and Oversight

Registered Auditors (ORAs) will receive

notifications prompting them to log in to the KnowHow

site. Upon first login, users will be required to update their

credentials. Each user has been assigned a unique username and will be prompted to create a password of

their choice.

We understand that transitions can raise questions, but

rest assured, the KnowHow platform is secure, and your

information is protected. Trust the process as we work

together to enhance your ADP experience.

The implementation of the LMS is expected to transform
