Dear Registered Auditor

It has come to our attention that an email (sent from a Gmail account) was received by a registered auditor regarding the IRBA's change of banking details from Standard Bank to First National Bank. These are common scams which indicate that emails have been intercepted. The IRBA has strict encryption standards to protect emails sent. Registered auditors are advised to review the security settings of their email accounts to prevent interception of their emails.
